THIS IS MOST IMPORTANT: Before uploading any of these pictures to *fotoLIBRA*, search the site for any other pictures of the building you intend to upload. If there are more than 50 photographs of it (e.g. Eiffel Tower, Selfridges Birmingham, Sydney Opera House, Sagrada Familia etc.) think long and hard before adding another to the pile, and only upload your picture if you are **sure and certain** it is better than the ones we already have.

If there are no pictures of the building you have photographed on our site, your chances of making a sale are greatly improved.

For example, we have 282 pictures of the Eiffel Tower and none of the BedZED in Wallington, Surrey. So at the moment your odds are 282 to 1 against getting your picture of the Eiffel Tower sold, and evens for your picture of the BedZED, whatever that is. But if your picture of the famous building is truly, truly spectacular, please go ahead and upload it. And don't forget to tell me!

There are 500 buildings on the list from all over the world, dating from the dawn of time to 2007.

Among your Keywords, please add the three digit picture number to BEB as the code keyword, so for example

001 / Pre-Historic / Cave Dwellings carved out of tufa stone, Goreme / Unknown / Turkey / Pre-Historic

should have BEB001 in the keywords and

250 / 1913 / Woolworth Building, New York, New York / Cass Gilbert / USA / Neo-Gothic

should have BEB250 in the keywords, with NO SPACES.
